After a brief PDL welcome and introduction to the Risk Management Cycle, participants will tackle the PDL BASECAMP challenge: a fast-paced relay built around one case study and four stations—Identify, Assess, Manage and Review. Working together to complete the challenge in 15 minutes, students and interns will build critical thinking, teamwork and risk-ready decision-making skills in a fun, engaging format.
